The NUS Students' Business Club, commonly known as Bizad Club, is the student-led organisation that represents all undergraduates pursuing the NUS BBA. Many activities organised by the Bizad Club (e.g. merchandise sales and bazaars) will be held in the vicinity of their club room here at Level 4.



Just a short walk from the Bizad Club room is The Terrace, a canteen strategically located at COM 3, right next to BIZ 2. Here, students from both faculties often grab a meal and recharge before their next class. The Terrace also houses a Coffee Bean & Tea Leaf, Smooy (frozen yoghurt), and the ever-popular halal eatery, Makan Boleh (we recommend their chicken rice).



Just around the corner from The Terrace is Cool Spot, a go-to haven for drinks, snacks, and a quick, hassle-free coffee fix. This (very cool) spot proudly displays photos of past NUS students who've walked these hallowed halls, a quiet testament to its legacy on campus. Don't be surprised when the friendly "bro" manning the stall remembers your exact order with just a glance at your face.



LT16 and LT17 are lecture theaters that BIZ students will quickly become familiar with. If you have lectures, they will likely take place here, and they're also frequently used during orientation for briefings and other activities. The best part? Cool Spot is located just outside LT16, which is perfect for a mid-lecture coffee break!

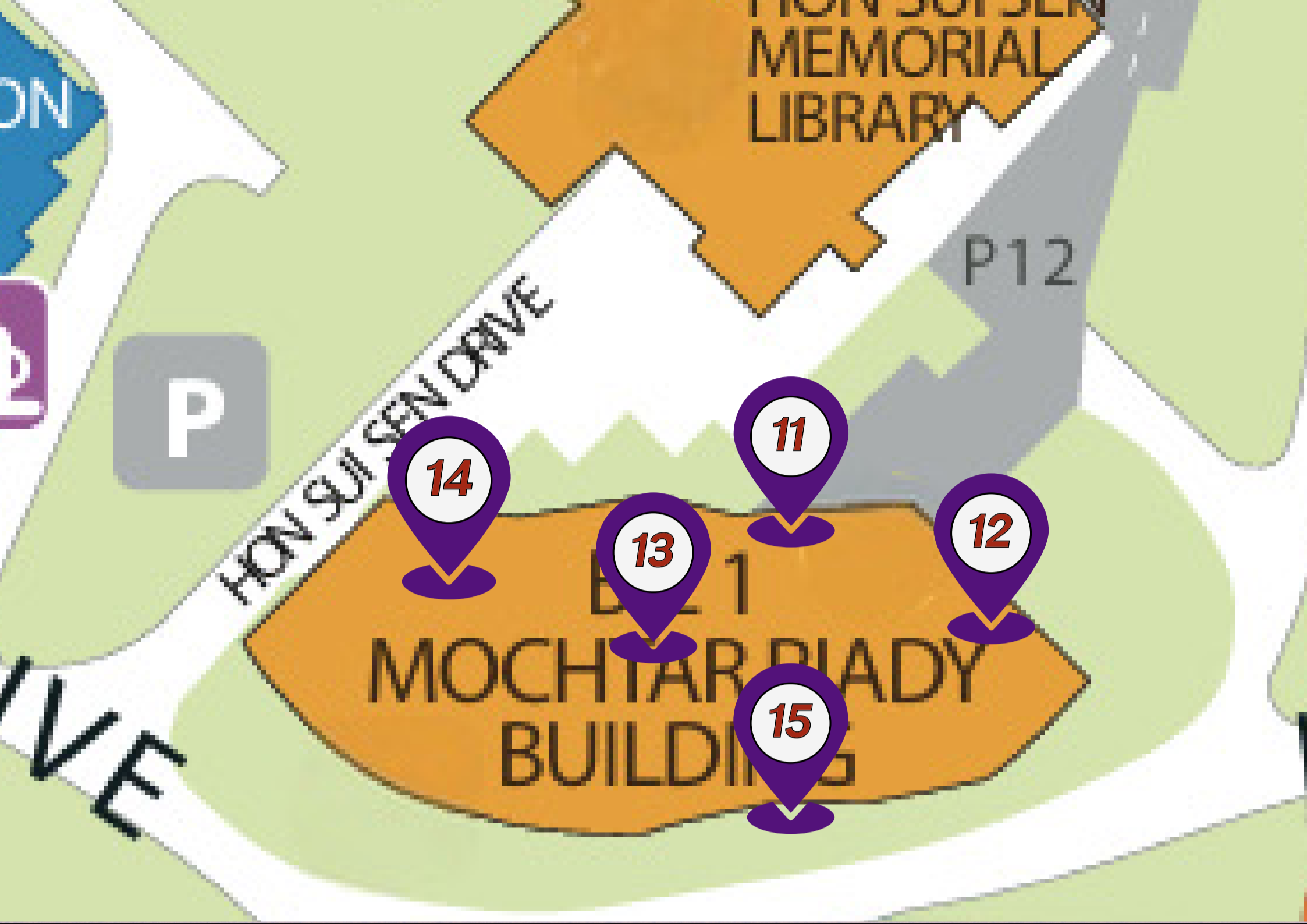
# HSSML Collection

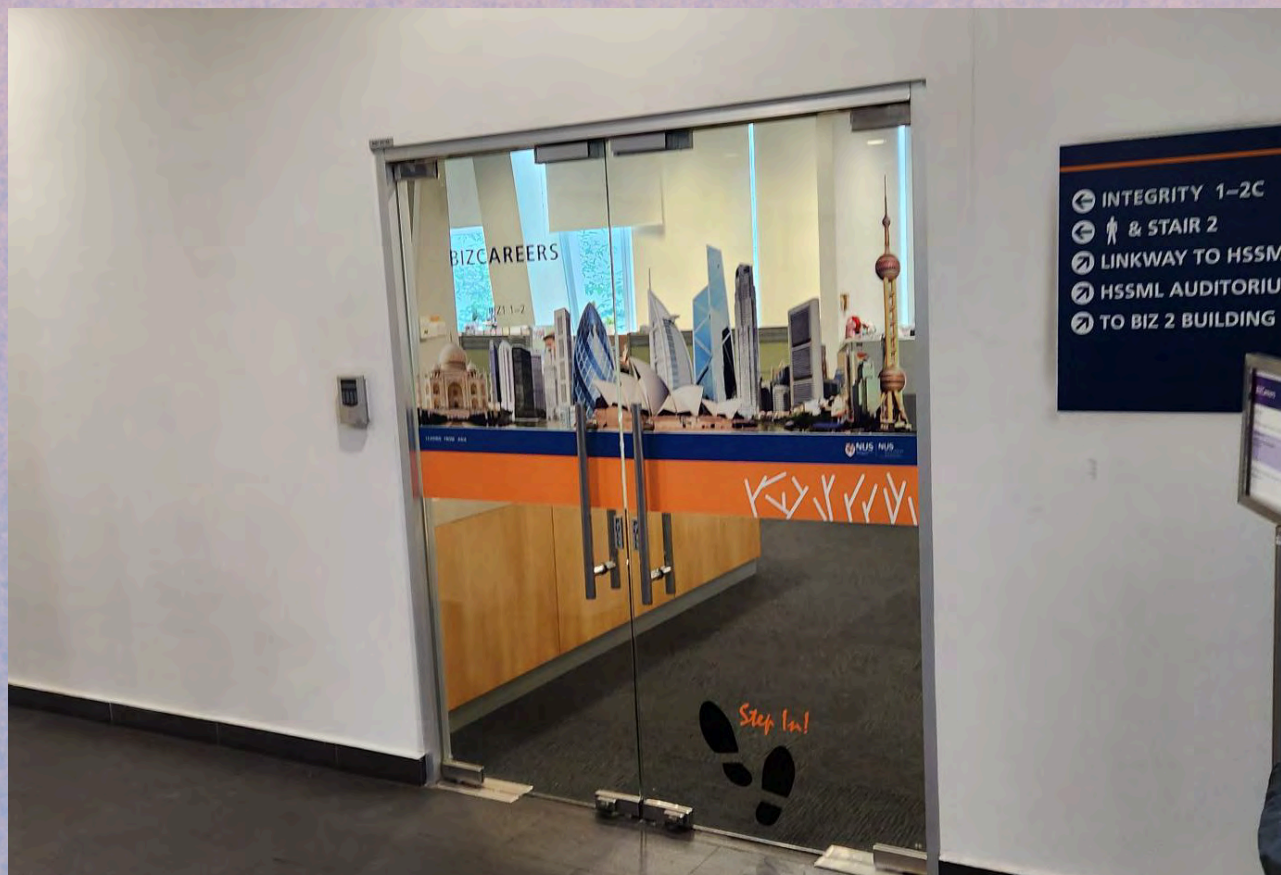

While you're there, check out the colourful Donor Wall, where we honour the generous contributions of our donors who have helped shape the future of NUS Business School.





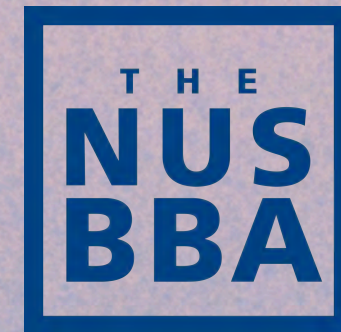
