Advanced Placement Credits Policy

Students granted Advanced Placement Credits (exemptions from relevant courses) will need fewer Units to complete their degrees and may even graduate earlier. Advanced Placement Tests are set at the respective University levels for the corresponding courses in the BBA programme. Click here for the 'Advanced Placement Course Outlines'.

Polytechnic Diploma Holders

Polytechnic diploma holders may be granted Advanced Placement Credits of up to 40 Units (exemptions for 10 courses) as follows:

- 20 Units from <u>Unrestricted Elective Courses</u> (UE) automatically granted upon admissions
- Up to 20 Units from BBA Programme Requirements may be granted based on good performance in the Advanced Placement Tests set by NUS Business School after an applicant has accepted NUS' offer of admission.

* Note: 20 Units for Unrestricted Elective (UE) Courses are automatic. No Advanced Placement Test is required. The full 20 Units exemption will be given to all polytechnic admission. However, whether the full 20 Units exemption is applicable will be dependent on the students' programme requirement and/or if the student pursues a 2nd Major/Minor programme as all courses read for a 2nd Major/Minor will come from the UE requirement.

Students who have previously studied at another institution and are transferring into the BBA Programme, are not permitted to take Advanced Placement Tests. These tests are for freshmen students.
