# NUS BBA Sample Study Plan (Notes)

- The sample study plans are for reference only. As a guide, students are recommended to read 40 units per year, 160 units for 4 years (minimum 18 units every semester).
- Students may adjust their plans to fit in their Global Experience Milestone (such as overseas exchanges/study trips) and Work Experience Milestone (such as internships/Work-Study Internship Programme) activities.
- To avoid situations where units are not transferred or processed in time for graduation, students are not allowed to embark on any overseas exchanges and credit-bearing internships in their final semester.
- Students must declare their primary BIZ major before the start of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester.

# NUS BBA Sample Study Plan (Notes – cont'd)

- Students are recommended to complete their Career Compass Starter Workshops (STR1000 and STR2000) before the end of their 6<sup>th</sup> semester.
- The General Education (GE) curriculum consists of 6 pillars. Students are strongly encouraged to start reading their GE courses early and no later than the 6<sup>th</sup> semester.
  - Specifically, students are recommended to complete the GE course under the Data Literacy pillar (GEAxxxx) no later than the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
  - Service learning courses under the Communities & Engagement pillar (GENxxxx) are mostly year-long courses and students should ensure that they can complete the course without disruption. - Students may complete a 2nd major (40 units), up to two minors (20 units) or credit-bearing internships (up to 12 units) subject to the availability of the UE space.

- Year-long service-learning course offered in both Semesters 1 and 2 of the Academic Year. Course code suffix X (offer in Sem 1); course code suffix Y (offer in Sem 2)
- GEN2060X and GEN2070X run till the end of Special Term 2 of that Academic Year (AY), when grades are awarded. Graduating students will not be able to join Commencement in the same AY of completion
- GEN2061 allows student to take semester-long break or be away during the Special Terms for SEP/Overseas internship/LOA and return to complete the course in the following semester
