

Information for NUS Business Students embarking on NOC studies pertaining to Biz/TR courses.

All Business Students must be familiar with their own studies/degree programme requirements; ie ULR (GE studies), Biz Degree Programme (ie Biz Core, Specialisation and Honours courses) and UE (Unrestricted Electives). NOC courses fall under UE requirements and cannot be counted toward Biz Degree Programme requirements, other than for the following exception/s:

(a) TR3203 - Start-up Case Study and Analysis (8 Units) can be read in place of FSP4003 Field Service Project

(b) TR3002N/TR3002 – can be read in place of BSN3702 New Venture Creation only if TR3002N/TR3002 is letter-graded (i.e. grades ranging from D to A+).

The above concession is subject to:

- the maximum 40% double counting rule (eg: if it is a 40MC NOC, both courses listed above can be double counted but if it is a 20MC NOC, only 1 of the above 2 courses can be double counted);
- and, the University-wide ruling that each NUS programme cannot have more than 40% of courses taken from overseas programmes, i.e. at least 60% of course requirements of each NUS programme must be taken in NUS. Eg, for the I&E specialization (5 courses, 20 Units in total), if students are double counting TR3002N, they can at most take 1 more course for the Specialization during another overseas programme, such as on an exchange programme.
