ADVANCED PLACEMENT OF COURSES IN THE BBA PROGRAMME

I take this opportunity to warmly welcome you to NUS Business School.

Before the new academic year commences, we would like to inform you that Advanced Placement Credits [obtained through the Advanced Placement Test (“APT”)] may be granted to students who are enrolling into the BBA programme in AY2026/27. Students who are granted Advanced Placement Credits from APT may be able to read fewer courses; hence, graduate earlier than the stipulated candidature.

Application to sit for APT is **optional**. If you wish to sit for APT, you are required to submit an [online application](#) and upload your transcript/s in a single PDF file. Please note that the online application portal will close by 11.59 pm on **12 June 2026 (Friday)**. We seek your understanding that late applications will strictly not be accepted after the online application portal is closed.

The outcome of your application to sit for APT will be released by **19 June 2026 (Friday)** via the email address stated in your application form. It is essential that you state this email address accurately. You are advised to check your inbox, spam, and junk folders promptly so as not to miss the release of your application outcome.

It is important to note that the respective APTs will take place **only once** between **6 July 2026 (Monday)** and **9 July 2026 (Thursday)** with **no** extension or make-up test dates available. Students who have sat for the APTs will receive their results via their NUS email by **17 July 2026 (Friday)**.
